Made with locally milled trees thinned from overgrown forests. Structure is moveable.

Cube & Reciprocal or Pyramid Roof

A wood roof with opening is joined to the top of the cube. A staircase joins the two. The loft serves as a temple and meditation space.

Finished Cube & Living Roof

Cube with door, windows and tipi style roof made of clay and soil.

Add-ons

- □ Walls made with cloth 5 /square foot
- □ Walls made with milled boards 8 /sf
- □ Wall insulation: straw, clay & cob 5 /sf
- □ Roof made with milled boards
- □ Cob floor & earthen finish 5 /sf
- □ Mass Heater and vent 500
- □ Cob bench/bed 400
- □ Living roof clay, soil, seeds 400
- □ Window or door 100 each
- □ Walipini greenhouse 2,000

Passive Solar Cube

Cube under a larger pyramid. Wood poles and boards from our mill provide slanted retaining wall around the cube. For optimal insulation, we bury the cube structure up to the top pyramid, leaving south face exposed to sun for greenhouse effect
